VISIT TO ARADHANA SCHOOL FOR SLOW LEARNER ORGANIZED BY SHAIKH COLLEGE OF EDUCATION BELGAVI



Students of Shaikh College of Education visited "Aradhana School for Slow Learner" on 23rd September 2022 under the guidance of Principal Dr. I. P. Sutar. Miss Usha. D.B and Mrs. Mubeena. Kazi. This school is dedicated belonging to various age groups and is run by government of Karnataka.

The children were very interactive and happy. They had issues which could be reduced through training and medication. They are having classes in three division which is mild, moderate and caviar. The teacher In-charge told them about their syllabus and how they are made capable to lead their daily lives. The students were happy to hear that many of their passed out student were living lives independently and some of them got married too. Once a differently abled child is born, their parents have a constant worry of who will take care of them after they leave; this school tries to reduce this tension of the parents by training their kids.

The Headmaster of this school Mr. Gajanana Sutar explained the students about the teaching procedure in this special school entails separately designed and methodically scrutinized compilation of coaching assessments, custom-made tools and equipments, along with the accessible settings. These intrusions are intended to aid students having special needs of attaining an advanced level of individual self-reliance and achievement in school, college and their society.

The session ended with few cultural programs by the children. This field visit was an eye opener to the reality of schools handling differently abled children. Their kids need a lot of attention and care for which there should be good facilities and faculties to handles. The students gained knowledge about it and hope to contribute to it in the future. The visit resulted in a memorable learning experience.
