The Department of Paediatrics organized a **Health Check-Up Camp** at Kadoli Gram Panchayat as part of its community outreach and preventive healthcare initiative. The camp focused on the screening of Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) among the local population.

During the camp, residents were screened for hypertension, diabetes, obesity, and other cardiovascular risk factors. The initiative aimed to promote early detection and raise awareness about lifestyle-related diseases.

A dedicated team comprising Dr. Nahida M. Mulla, Dr. Kedar Samaji, Dr. Swati, along with interns and students, actively participated in conducting clinical examinations and offering medical advice. In addition to screenings, health education sessions were conducted to emphasize the importance of a balanced diet, regular physical activity, and the avoidance of tobacco and alcohol.

Free homoeopathic medicines were distributed based on individual assessments. Patients requiring further evaluation or specialized care were referred to appropriate healthcare facilities. The camp received a positive response from the community, underscoring the importance of preventive healthcare initiatives at the grassroots level.
